

PROGRAMME POSTGRAD YEAR 1

CONDITIONS

Minimum age: 21

In order to apply for the postgraduate programme, students need to have a thorough knowledge of photoshop, illustrator and indesign as well as a good understanding of calligraphy and typography. This programme is the ideal follow up for ELI students who completed the foundation course, wanting to deepen their knowledge over a period of two years, but also opens its doors for students holding a graphics design degree or any equivalent degree in the graphic, lettering and book arts.

SUBJECT AREAS

Students signing up for this programme will have the opportunity to personalize their tuition programme in agreement with the director and staff. This two year period will be spent on gaining a thorough and deeper understanding of one of the lettering related fields:

1. formal or informal calligraphy
2. letter drawing-typographic/ font research
3. logo design: letter drawing/calligraphy/graphic design
4. graphic design: a more general application of lettering as a total project

Students will be invited to do serious comparative research, strengthen weaker skills and deepen knowledge in the chosen field. By the end of year 1, students will be asked to define their project for their master assignment.

SUBSCRIPTION FEES 2018-2019:

Full-time 3 days / week 5450 euros (all seminars included)

The two year postgraduate programme only exists as full time tuition. Part-time tuition is not possible.

HOW TO APPLY:

Please send us your CV and a motivation letter via mail. We will contact you and if favourable, you will receive an invitation to show your work in our school. It will give us the opportunity to get to know you better. For students living abroad, this appointment can be replaced by a Skype meeting. ELI students who finished their foundation course don't need to apply again, but can notify us of their desire to sign up for this programme. You will be sent the subscription papers together with your evaluation at the end of the academic year.

Overseas students will need a visa to study in Belgium. Since regulations have become more strict, we advise you to please contact us for more details **before** contacting the Embassy. Please note that it takes upto at least 8 weeks before receiving your visa.

PRACTICAL INFORMATION:

The school opens at 9:00am and closes on course days at 5:30pm.

Classes take place on Monday, Tuesday and Thursday from 9:30am till 4:30pm.

School holidays are to be found online and students will be informed well in time should changes occur.

Students can use the school library during opening hours. No books can be taken home.

All courses take place -unless stated otherwise- in Brugge, Peterseliestraat 23A, Belgium.

Please note that this is a private course and can only submit, upon graduation, a private training certificate.
